- The committee is looking into possible sites for the 2014 shows. The Gruppe Gallery in June of 2014 right before Open Studio Weekend and possibly the Flynn in the Fall or in 2015. Discussed other possible venues for 2014. Waitsfield Red Barn is another option. Reggie is checking into the Ludlow Community Center.
- Mark talked about the Towle Hill Studio as a good site for a small hub show, holds 20 entries.

- We have purchased an overhead mirror to use for demos paid for from our raffle money intake.
- Members have complained about the cost of the meetings. Discussed possibly lowering the cost and supplementing

- Will raffle off a Craig Young style palette, 2 CDs from Creative Catalyst,
- Sarah will introduce herself and do short presentation using her slide projector.

- Claudia wants to buy a digital projector. Mark told her she can buy it using our funds. Therefore Sarah can use this at the Spring Meeting.
- Frank Eber Workshop will be offered Oct. 5-9, 2015.
- Linda Kemp Sept. 9-13, 10 people signed up so far.
- John Salmanen workshop June 23-27, 2014, the registration form is on the website and inquiries are coming in to Claudia.
- Claudia to hand out workshop fliers at the Spring Mtg.

## Communications Report - Sarah Rosedahl

- She sent an invitation to the Vermont Art Teaches Assoc. to come to the Spring Meeting. Some may come and
  - Others may not due to the different vacation weeks in different school districts.
- Amanda has talked to Burlington College and is meeting with them next week to talk about our
  organization and working to create a possible relationship with them. A wide variety of ideas were
  brainstormed by board members: having a space on the campus for meetings classes and storing our
  equipment; doing workshops or demonstrations there; location for a hub show. Discussions may begin
  with the College about how our interests and goals dovetail.

## **OTHER**

- Discussed the insurance policies and voted to approve them. Unanimous vote in favor of insurance.
- VTICA Survey: Discussed it and decided to let the previous board decision based on the survey results.
- Discussion of a possible trip to Boston to the John Singer Sargent Show in October: Mark suggested that if we could fashion a real outreach program we might use VWS funds to offset some of the costs. Claudia will look into the cost of a bus rental, show date etc. She will also post it in Snippets to see what interest there is and more details to follow if there is sufficient interest. Hubs can go and use their budgets to defray the cost.
- The New Brochure: We need to pick pictures and members can submit them. Sarah will put submissions into Flicker. Pam and Amanda will jury submissions. Sarah and Amanda will work on brochure layout.
- Claudia talked about needing ideas for different workshops and activities. She needs someone to check into different places to have them.
- We discussed subsidizing hub trips but it is a complicated issue and will discuss it again in the future.

• We talked about buying some Creative Catalyst CDs to be lent out to hubs to use. Pam will bring this up to the point persons at the Rally next week to see if they are interested.
